Quick to make using any left-over yarns you might have!

## Materials:

1 oz Caron Simply Soft Yarn  
Size F hook

## Directions:

Ch 28.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next 4 sc; ch 2, sk next 2 ch, sc in next ch and in each ch to end. Ch 1, turn. (25 sc)

**Row 2:** Sc in next 20 sc, ch 2, skip ch 2, sc in last 5 sc. Ch 1, turn.

**Row 3:** Sc in next 5 sc, ch 2, sk ch 2, sc in last 20 sc. Ch 1, turn.

**Rows 4-29:** Repeat rows 2 and 3.

**Row 30:** Repeat row 2. Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew seam.

Whip stitch together rows 1 and 30.

## Tie:

Chain 75. Fasten Off. Weave through ch 2 spaces at the top of the hat. Tie in a bow.

Fold cuff over the top.

You can adjust the size of this little hat by using different yarn and / or hooks. I have used the exact pattern with out changing stitches or rows with a variety of yarns!
